

The College of Podiatry: Guidance on the Supply of Codeine Phosphate, Co-Codamol and Co-Dydramol

The College of Podiatry advises members with the appropriate annotation (POM-S) that a maximum of a three days' supply of the following medicines is permissible prior to review of the patient: Codeine Phosphate, Co-Codamol and Co-Dydramol (to a maximum of 10/500). The College also emphasises that members should only use a signed order requiring the medicines to be dispensed by a pharmacist. Signed orders should advise the pharmacist of the dose and frequency to be used. Individual supplies should not be held by members. The 'POM-S' certification requires a College of Podiatry recognised update every three years for members.
