Pass/Fail	Clinical examination to assess students' competency to treat patients and assess practical skills development. 1.5 hours Pass/Fail	Individual presentation and Viva assessing how students contextualise their role in the health care environment. 50% 15 minutes	Written examination (Multiple Choice Questions, Extended Matching Questions and case studies). 1.5 hours 100%	Midpoint end of term OSCE assessed in-house by academic staff before students going on placement. 30% 1 hour. Practical OSPE assessed via a simulated scenario by academic member of staff Pass/Fail	Verbal feedback in group discussions during lectures and tutorials. Practice questions throughout continuous clinical assessment feedback.

The important points to consider are:</p> <p align="center">1. Assessment should be varied to ensure it is inclusive to all learning styles.</p> <p align="center">2. Assessments should not be focussed on the ability to simply memorise information, but should focus on understanding, application, competence and intellectual mastery of the disciplines in real world contexts where the student is required to demonstrate relevant knowledge, skills, and professional attitudes.</p>
