**VENUE  
LOCATION**

- Manchester to Birmingham: 2 hours via the M6 or 1 hour 40 minutes by train
- Newcastle to Birmingham: 3 hours 40 minutes via the A1(M) or 3 and a half hours by train
- Leeds to Birmingham: 2 hours 20 minutes via the M1 or 2 hours by train
- London to Birmingham: 3 hours via the M40 or 1 and a half hours by train.

If you're planning on arriving into the city by rail, the hotel is situated 15 minutes by foot from Birmingham New Street station.

**PARKING INFORMATION**

Paid parking is available at the hotel's onsite car park, which has 200 parking spaces. Please note that the hotel's postcode is B1 2HQ, though in order to access the car park on Berkley Street, please use the postcode B1 2LF. The cost per 24 hours is £16.50.

There is a height restriction of 1.7m. The following tariffs apply:

- Up to 1 hour: £2.50
- Up to 2 hours: £4.00
- Up to 3 hours: £5.00
- 4 to 6 hours: £8.00
- 7 to 10 hours: £11.50
- 11 to 24 hours: £16.50

Please note: Charges will apply up to 30 minutes past the hour after which the charge goes to the next price point. For example, if parked up to one hour thirty minutes, the charge is £2.50. If parked for one hour thirty-one minutes the charge is £4.00.

There is a height restriction of 1.7m in the multistorey car park. Parking cannot be pre-booked in advance. The hotel does not accept liability or responsibility for any damages caused to vehicles whilst using the car park. The nearest public car park is a 4 minute walk away at Brindley Place. It is open 24 hours, and the cost is £20.00 for 24 hours.

**BIRMINGHAM CLEAN  
AIR ZONE**
